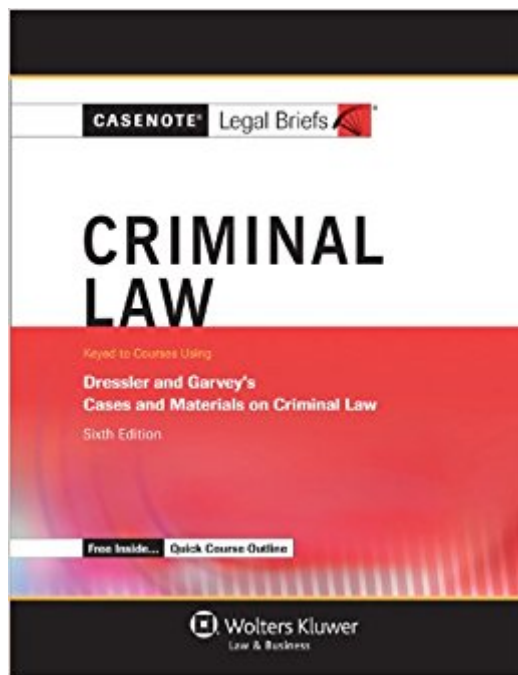


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First year law student here and this was a nice tool to have. Basically, reading the brief prior to doing your actual readings can help to give you a heads up of what to pay attention to before delving into the details.

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
