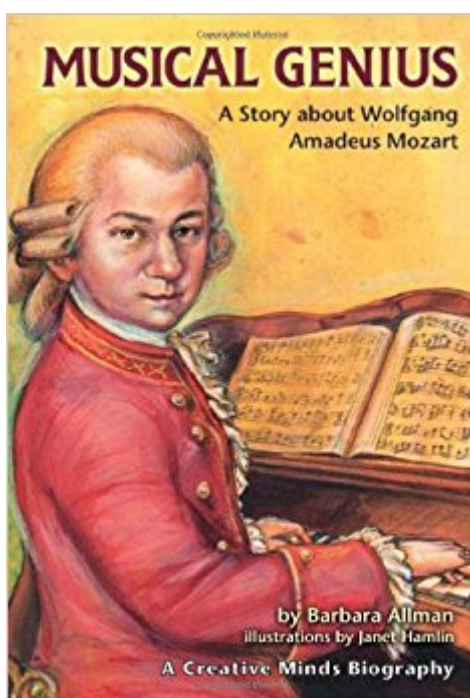


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Musical Genius: A Story About Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart (Creative Minds Biography) (Creative Minds Biography (Paperback))
