

I found this book "by chance" & bought a copy, thinking it might be useful for my junior high girls. I've been using it for my Bible studies with 6th and 8th graders. This book has been excellent! I do believe it needs to be in every youth pastor's arsenal. It is so well organized, well written, so honest,
