

I picked up this book hoping to find a great new textbook to add to a class that I was teaching on the prophets. I was disappointed with the scholarly level of the book, but it was probably because I was searching for an additional scholarly source. While this book may not compare to a textbook by Wayne Grudem, it does not aim to do so and I am truly blessed for having read it. Not only was it a far more interesting read than a textbook, it was also a great book of the author's personal story and dealings with prophecy. It has moved me to renew with fervor my prayers for the state of our world and a move back to God. This is not to say that the book was not well written and researched, but for me it was more about the personal message that God has for us today. Mathew Payne truly understands the prophet's role in the modern world. As a Biblical Scholar I would recommend this book to anyone, but especially those with a hunger to change the world for God's kingdom. If you feel that tugging on your heart, then pick up this book; I know you will be blessed by reading it. I was.

The concept of modern-day prophecy has always been something that intrigued me, but I never

really knew enough about it. The main concept of the book is a discussion on prophecy, not in the sense of the "end times" prophecy, but in the sense of "prophesying" (modern day prophetic experiences and revelations). The book seeks to answer the questions:<sup>\*</sup> What is prophecy?<sup>\*</sup> Can anyone prophesy?<sup>\*</sup> How can one tell a false prophet? These are questions that I really never thought too much about it, even though the Bible is full of references to prophecy from beginning to end. For some reason, I never really believed most modern day accounts of prophecy because so many religious leaders use their power in unhealthy powers. Reading this book, however, actually made me confront my own ideas about it. The book took a different perspective stance of prophecy than I expected. Instead of being something reserved for a special few (which the authors don't deny), the authors expand the definition of prophecy to include everyone. Payne and Hicks treat prophecy as a spiritual development capable of all Christians who are ready. This development, however, requires considerable understanding, support, and guidance which I feel that beginning Christians may not have just starting out. Overall, this is a great book if you believe or are willing to believe in modern day prophecy. It is well put together and is easy to follow along with. The book is also organized pretty well and has questions that would be great for a spiritual reflection. It is also deeply inspirational and can definitely serve as a devotional. Reading this book definitely inspired me and challenged my own perspectives of faith. I see the word "prophecy" a little differently now. Even if you don't believe in the claims in the book, there is still plenty of spiritual "food for thought", particularly when it comes to prophecy. There only two concerns I have with the book is the early approach to the book and organization. The book launches into a discussion of one the author's prophetic experiences. While this does provide insight into why the book was written, I was caught unaware. The author begins with a discussion of several supernatural occurrences that happened in his personal life. It then launched into discussion about the "prophetic". I would have placed some of the chapters that discuss the concept of prophecy slightly earlier in the book. As a person not used to prophecy used in this way, I was not sure I understood concretely some of topics covered. If you are familiar with these concepts, you should have no problem going through the book. In either case, I came away more inspired about my own faith and the faith that the Biblical prophets had. I may have some slight disagreements about what they said, but I was glad that they started the conversation.

The wealth of information is amazing. Prophecy is explained in a simple way so that to show this gift is from God. Warm and personal, every chapter comes to life with important information about today's prophets. Blending God's supernatural powers with a pinch of psychological insight, the drama of living to prophesize unfolds. Written so beginners will understand and anyone at all with curiosity will find it worth reading. It's a guide for learning about prophecy and how to deal with it, if you are chosen by God. "However, the point is: He chose you to be His mouthpiece and what a privilege that is." Chapter 10. Reading about the changes that took place in Matthew and Laurie's lives you will see a little bit of the strange behavior from people that they approached; skittishness and concern from the ones they were chosen to prophesize to. That was a pattern that came and went, and how they stayed with the faith to learn about prophesizing more and understand what the prophetic messages meant was a daring act of faith on their part. With guidance of Ministers, a Bishop and other religious figures in their lives they accepted this gift, nourished it, and helped many people with the various prophesies they received. A revelation that they were blessed to receive and accept, but not without the many challenges. Miraculously, they are two totally different people approached by God with this wonderful gift and brought together for this special reason to share His word. I love the way the book is set up; Matthew begins with each fantastic chapter filled with intriguing experiences, biblical situations, and more, and Laurie then shares her reflections on them which are colorful and exciting. The Prophetic Supernatural Experience is a book you will enjoy and cherish. Very well written and it opens up doors to God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit.
