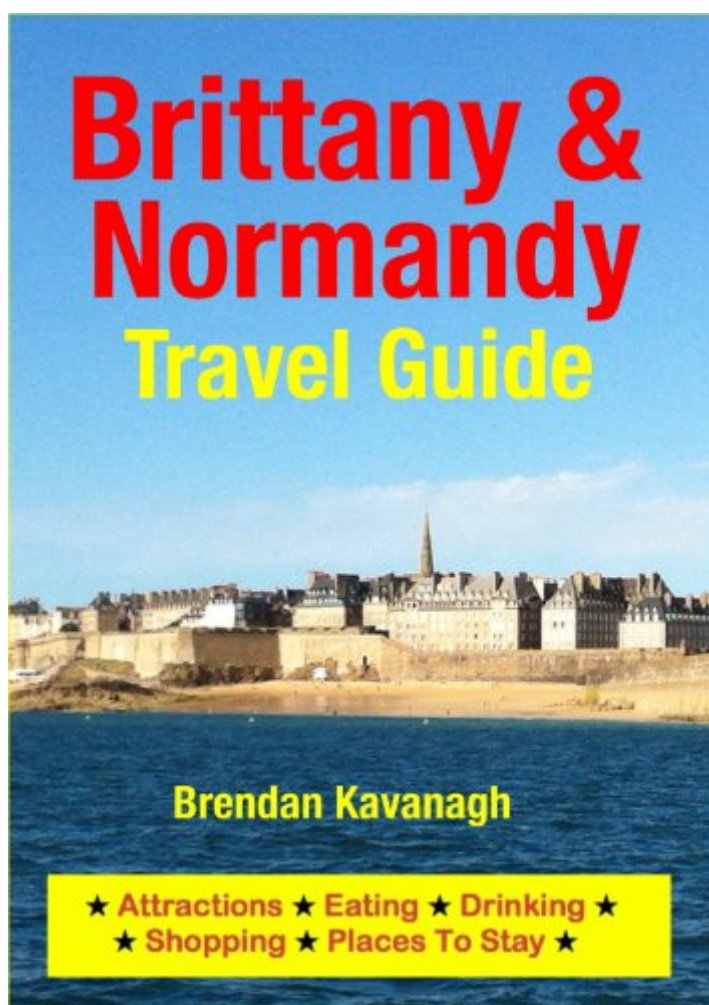

I bough this for a week-plus trip to Brittany. It provides a good, brief overview of the area. Although it would not suffice as a sole guidebook (we used 3 different guides), it has much information and is a great value at this price.

Poor enough details on Brittany. Just about adequate. There are probably better guide books on Brittany out there.

A bit superficial..but as an introducciÃ n it's Ok.

This guide is completely and totally worthless. It is about 75 pages long, has huge type, and offers absolutely no information other than what you could read on the most basic internet sites. It lists few hotels for both departments, and does not even mention Mont St. Michel, one of the great highlights of Brittany. Save your money and buy a real guidebook.
