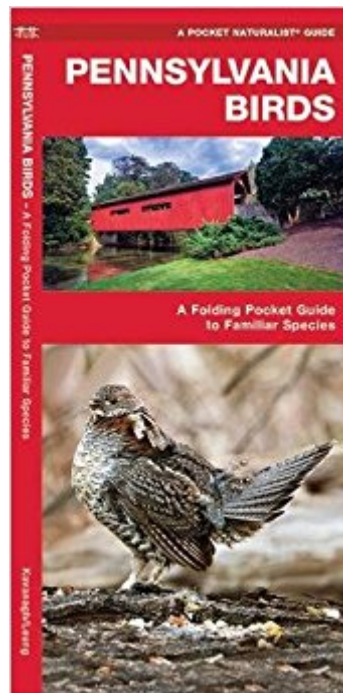

These quick reference cards are amazingly easy to use and very helpful identifying birds quickly. I also purchased my 3rd Eastern Backyard Birds along with this one. Please note, This is a field guide. Not a book as I thought. It is a one page cardboard picture of birds and their names, folded in 3. Not a value + postage....

We are new to birding, and we bought this folding pocket chart along with Peterson's guide when we first began. My kids and I LOVE this little guide because it only features familiar species in your state/area, so when you're trying to figure out what that blue/gray/white bird is that just landed at

your feeder, you don't have to search through dozens of images feeling a bit overwhelmed, and THINK you ID'd it only to realize that bird you THOUGHT it was is not found in your area. It's so nice to have this small guide handy when we watch our feeder, and when we want to know MORE detail about the bird we ID'd, we pull out our Peterson's guide. I highly recommend this for any beginning birder.

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
