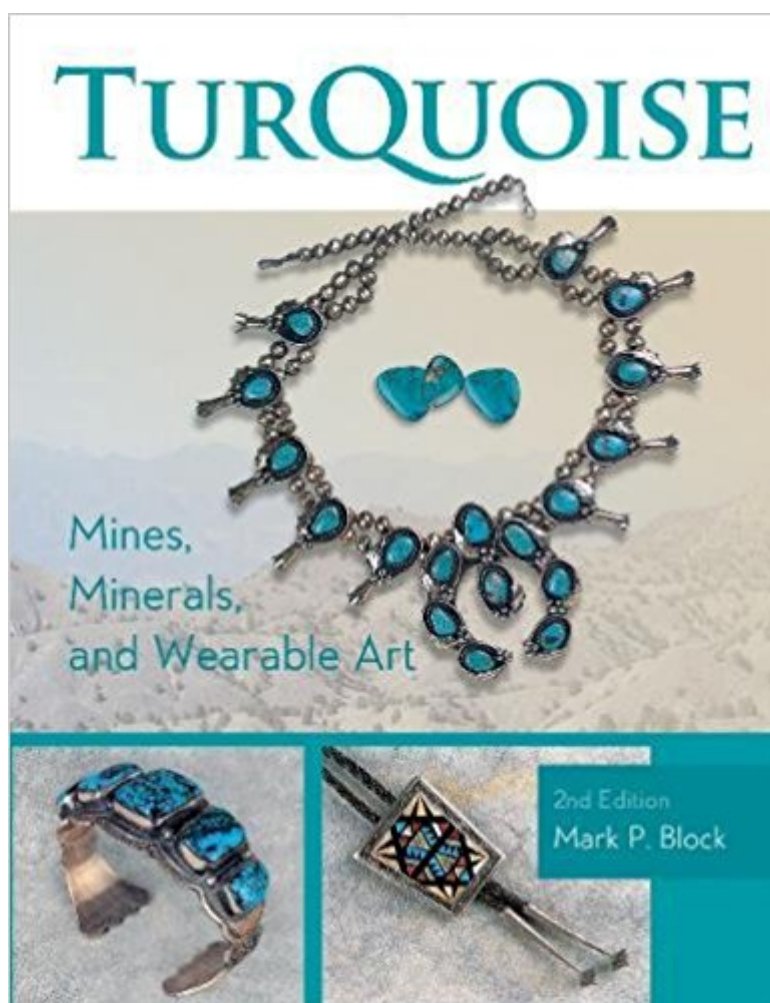


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Turquoise Mines, Minerals, And Wearable Art, 2nd Edition
