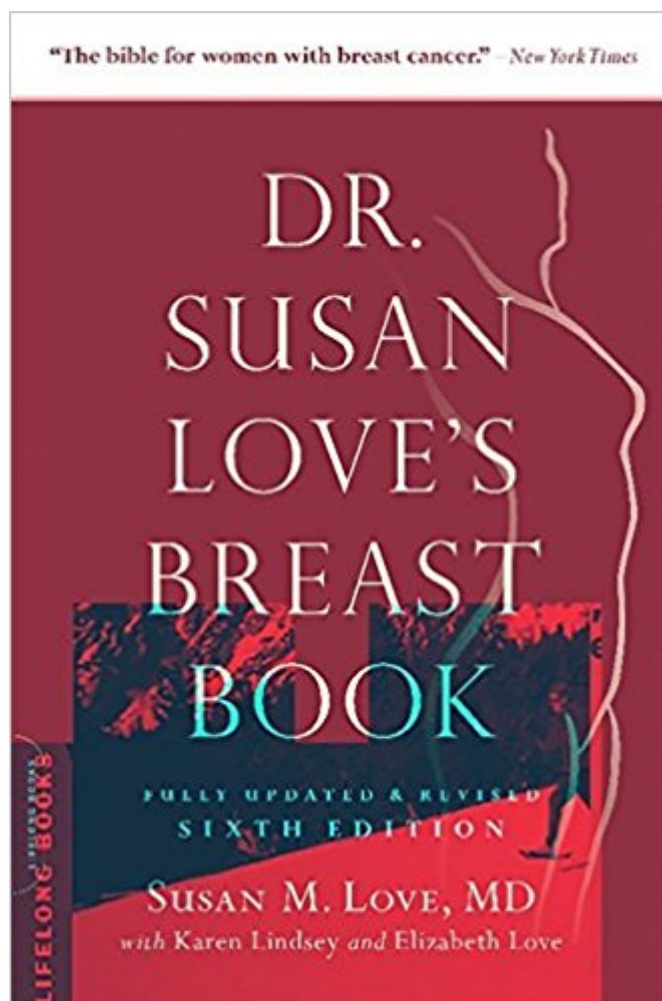


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Dr. Susan Love's Breast Book (A Merloyd Lawrence Book)
