

## Synopsis

There are 36 entries in the guide to the Swedish capital, incorporating our usual range of interests: good food and coffee, cultural pursuits and shops. There's Biologika Museet, a 19th-century natural history museum of staggering strangeness, rainwear from Stutterheim, salty caramel from PÃ¤rlans Konfektyr and intimate eating at Bakfickan. Printed on a single sheet of 100% recycled paper, these light, portable guides are an ideal travelling companion.

We seek out the well-used and much-loved, and enjoy the extraordinary as well as the everyday. The map looks cool and most of the recommendations I visited were good (nothing like a WOW!), but I was not impressed that the locations on the actual map are "around that area"...you cannot actually use the map for navigation! I had to use the map from my other guidebook along with the

map. To be honest, given it is just a big piece of paper, the price seems high.

This should not be called a 'map'. It's useless - simply a list of a few places to visit - probably compiled in an afternoon by the authors.
