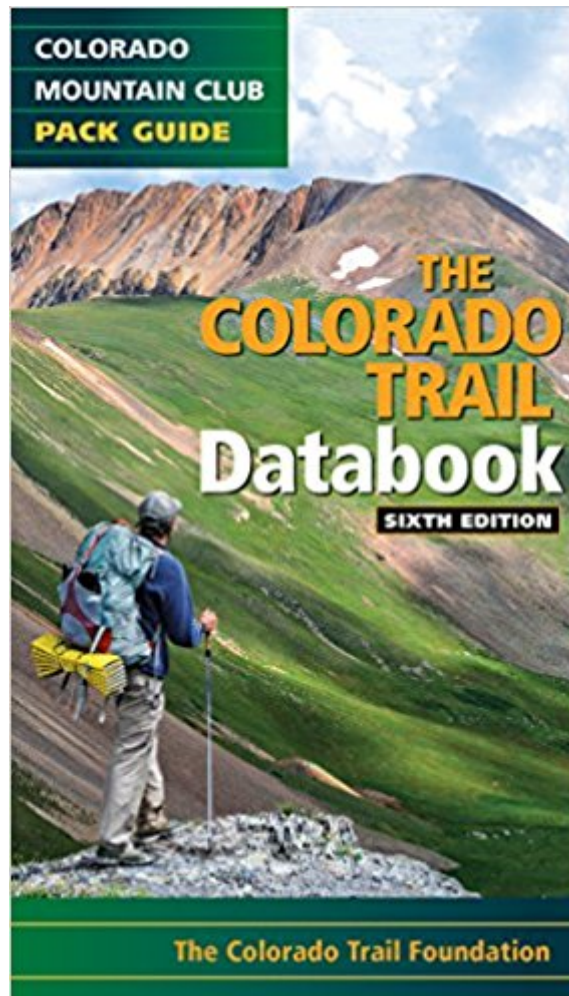

The book is great but it is difficult to read because the font is so tiny.

Perfect size and packed with a ton of practical information one might need when on the CT. Maps are diagrammatic with not alot of detail but it's a databook not mapbook. Combine with some map app on your phone and good to go. 5 star if it had waterproof paper like the national geographic maps.

Good information at your fingertips

The databook shows mostly accurate information. Please keep in mind the data may be different than the actual environment when on the trail depending on when you start. Starting in early June yielded a lot more water sources than anticipated by the databook. Double check local resources before you start to be sure!

The book is well done. I had searched for a trail guide for the Colorado section of the Continental Divide Trail, so thought this book went with the Divide books...so it wasn't what I needed, but it is a good resource.

The data book is excellent. It is everything you need for the CT. Trailheads, waypoints, water, campgrounds and more.
