

Nice lay out of book and clear coloured pages of instruments with alternative names to them. Lots of information in the book

I found the book of only little help. Many instruments are not in the book. The pictures and descriptions need to be done over. The pictures do not show the instruments well, especially different angles and close up as really is necessary to know what you're looking at, because you need to memorize them by sight. Color pictures would also be much better for seeing the teeth and groove, twist, and angles of the instruments, etc. The descriptions are also lacking in that there are more common and multiple names for many of the instruments that are not listed. By far color pictures, from 3-4 different angles and close shots would be highly beneficial. Had I seen an older copy of this book, I would not have purchased the copy, edition I did buy.
