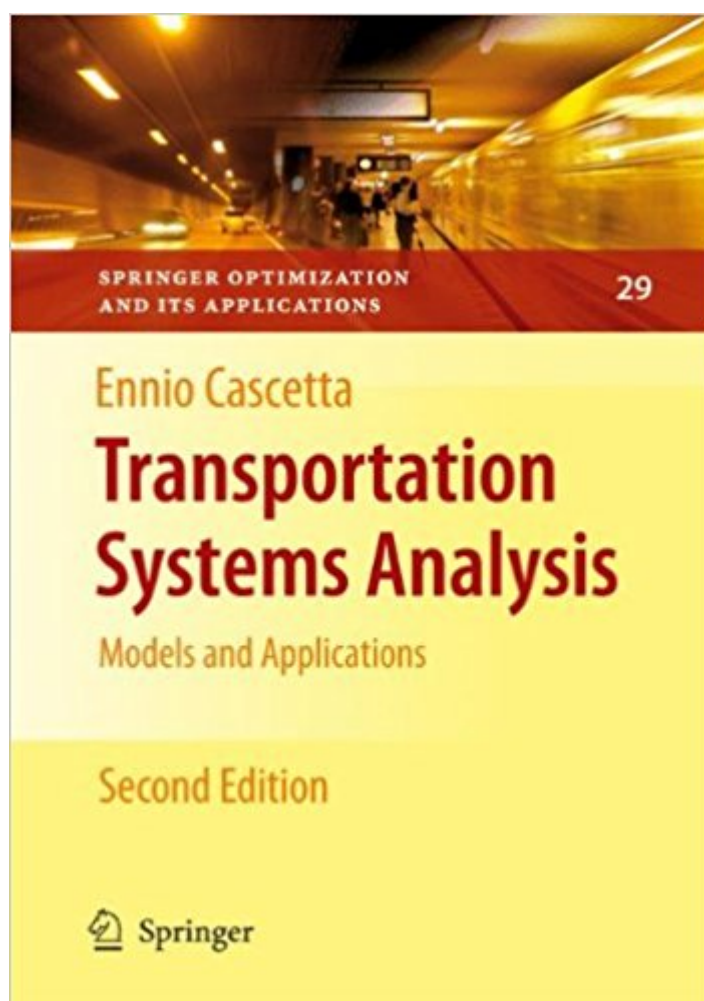


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Transportation Systems Analysis: Models And Applications (Springer Optimization And Its Applications)
