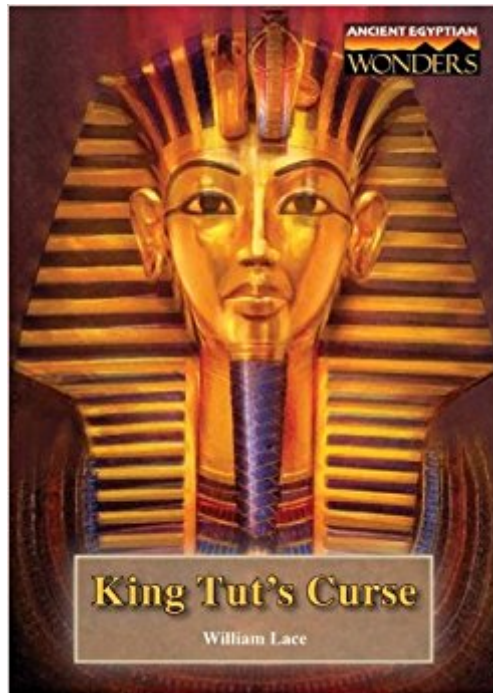

Gr 8 Up-This series provides a wealth of information on the ancient Egyptians, focusing on the infamous curse of King Tut, the pyramids of Giza, pharaohs, mummification and burial rites, and daily life. Even though this is oft-covered ground, these books stand out for their abundant material and the appealing presentations. The content is extensive, but it is written in a conversational style that will pull in report writers and browsers alike. The main text is interspersed with fact boxes providing additional intriguing tidbits ("The Great Pyramid of Khufu at Giza weighs an estimated 6 million tons."), interesting photographs, and noteworthy artwork and reproductions. This Ancient Egyptian Wonders series entry explores the legend of King Tutâ™s curseâ™its origination, how it spread, and the remaining mysteries and search for answers. The title opens with Lord Carnarvonâ™s 1923 death (one of the original discoverers of King Tutâ™s tomb) and continues on to discuss Tutankhamenâ™s life, rule, and death (including recent DNA testing, which indicates he had malaria) as well as the endeavors of those involved in the tombâ™s discovery. Additional chapters explore what fueled curse rumors, particularly the many deaths of those connected to the tomb. Descriptive, often anecdotally related text intersperses facts, sidebars, and sourced quoted material, along with color visuals ranging from maps to an ancient Egypt time line to photos of a sarcophagus and Tutâ™s mummified head. Chapter notes and further reading add substance to this readable, engaging offering. Grades 6-9. --Shelle Rosenfeld

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
