


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# Knopf MapGuide: Naples (Knopf Mapguides)

I love this whole series. I used one book in Paris and another in Naples and loved them both. The maps are great: they highlight key areas of interest, they are easy to read, and they are accurate. The book itself is well-designed - the maps are easy to access, the book FITS in a purse and it is LIGHT. I cannot tell you how important that is if you are walking around all day with a travel book in your purse, you want it to be LIGHT. Put a thicker, more comprehensive (i.e. weighs a pound) travel book in your rolly suitcase so you can read sections of it on the plane or in the hotel room, but bring the Knopf Mapguide along with you as you explore the streets of whatever awesome place you are in. In terms of content - these books try to include a mix of high-profile things (ex. the Ponte Vecchio in Naples) but balance it with well-chosen restaurants, shops, and things you might visit if you have time (ex. the old roman amphitheatre in Paris, which I found down an alley and no other tourists were there...). I personally like the way it splits up a city by neighborhood so you get a sense of what the city is like right away, and can sort of divide and conquer section-by-section. I cannot recommend this series enough.

I know this is "old" tech but I really like the format. I've used the one for Paris and will be using the

one for Rome. It's the perfect size and weight and I don't have to rely on batteries or WiFi. Because each map lists major sites, restaurants, cafes and shops it also helps me plan what I want to read up on.
