

In 1964 Chuck Cantwell was hired as project engineer by Carroll Shelby for Shelby American's new Mustang GT350 effort, leading development on several years worth of both racing and street versions of the GT350. He later managed road racing teams for Penske Racing, scoring multiple championships in both the Trans-Am and Can-Am series between 1969 and 1973. After leaving Penske in 1974, Chuck worked for Chilton Publishing as Director of Automotive Special Projects for nine years and retired from Lockheed Martin after 17 years as a Senior Systems Analyst. Chuck often shares his motor racing knowledge and experiences with enthusiasts, speaking at Shelby American Automobile Club (SAAC), and Antique Automobile Club of America (AACA) events. Greg Kolasa is registrar for the Shelby American Automobile Club (SAAC) on the Ford GT40 and Hertz Shelby Mustangs, co-authoring several editions of SAAC's World Registries. He is the author of two books on Shelby Mustangs.
