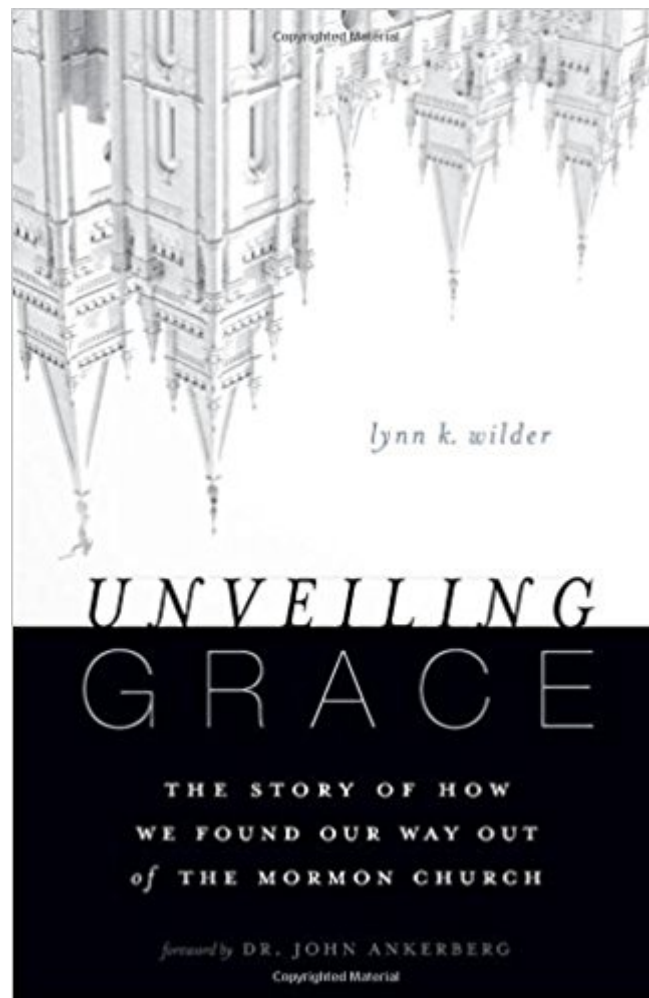

Lynn K. Wilder is a wife, mother, grandmother, scholar, and author with a doctorate in education. In her 12 years as a professor and researcher, and 20 years as a teacher, she has mentored thousands of students and has produced more than 50 scholarly publications, including two books on positive behavior support and a book comparing Mormon and Bible doctrines, *7 Reasons We Left Mormonism*. Once a tenured faculty member at Brigham Young University, Dr. Wilder left in 2008 when she experienced a crisis of faith. --This text refers to an out of print or unavailable edition of this title.
