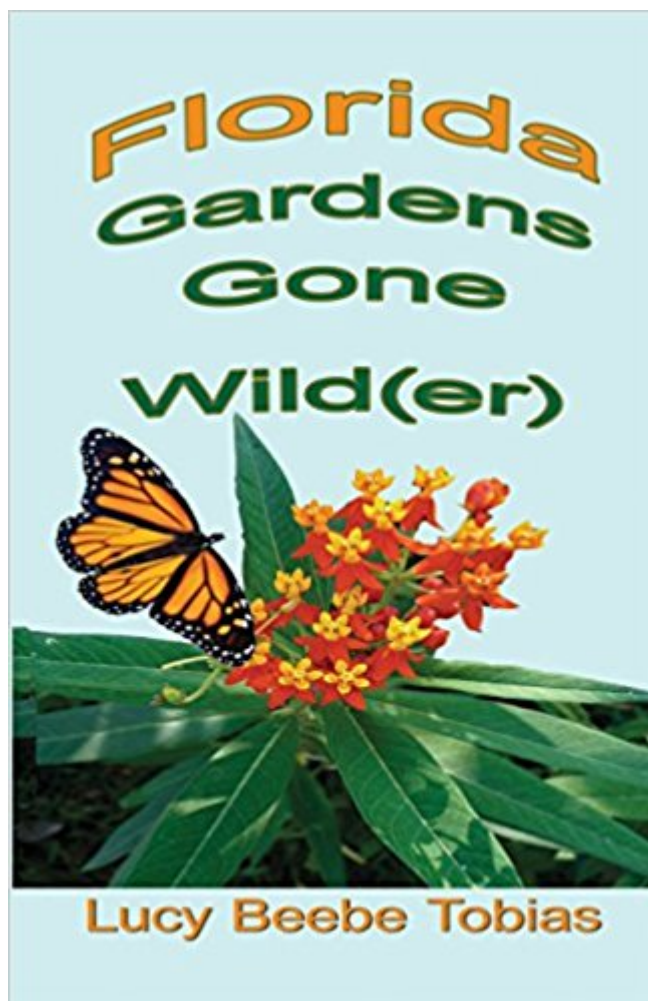

When it comes to plants and gardening I had always ascribed to the theory of "benign neglect" - but in experiencing Lucy Beebe Tobias' "FL Gardening Gone Wild" first hand, I discovered that it is so much more than just digging in the dirt...it is about connecting...with yourself, with the earth, with the environment, with each other's passions and talents - to learn, to escape, to grow (literally and figuratively) - to be a part of something greater than oneself. Florida Gardens Gone WildÂ packs a lot of valuable information for those interested in gardening, visiting botanical gardens, and learning something about the Sunshine State. This is a terrific resource guide which includes information for planning a Florida garden and where to view some of Florida's spectacular botanicals. Author Lucy Beebe Tobias has also included fun and delightful personal stories from her garden, travels and friends. I've lived in Florida for 15 years and thought I knew everything about the state but after reading this book, I learned about a few new places to visit. I also learned what "Locavore" means and found out I am one! Images pop in the Kindle version of the book and the "Digging It" section at the end of most chapters contains links and resources for additional information. This is a book I'll reference often when I'm ready for my next adventure and ready to start my own garden.

Gardening in Florida is very different than gardening "up north," i.e., planting tomatoes in the fall? This book is a must-read for anyone new to Florida. For those of us who have been here a while, it's full of tips that we can use, too. All that, plus it's injected with Lucy's "laugh-out-loud observations of her everyday life with cats and dogs and geckos and gardens. Savor this book the first time you read it, then save it for reference sources in the "digging it" section at the end of each chapter. A great bargain - buy two!
