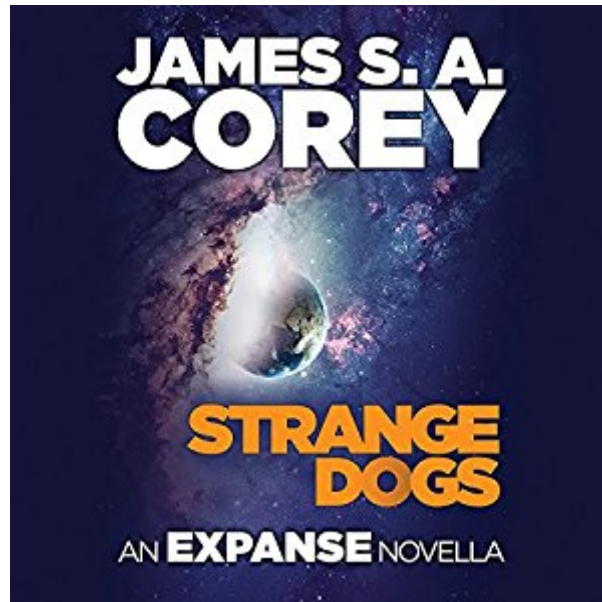


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Strange Dogs: An Expanse Novella

I've enjoyed most every story in the Expanse series, and this novella is no exception. Written from the perspective of a young girl living on one of the newly colonized worlds, a series of inexplicable and somewhat sinister events are related to us through the filter of her innocence and youth. The story is interesting and well paced. It also has the advantage of being self-contained: despite being set in the Expanse universe, there are very few references to events occurring elsewhere. Coming from a child's POV it reads nothing like anything else in The Expanse and has the stylings of a coming of age story, but still manages to mix in sci-fi postulation about how humanity adapts to its environment and opens up a whole new can of worms for The Expanse franchise. A nice, but also essential diversion for following the progress of the 'verse.
