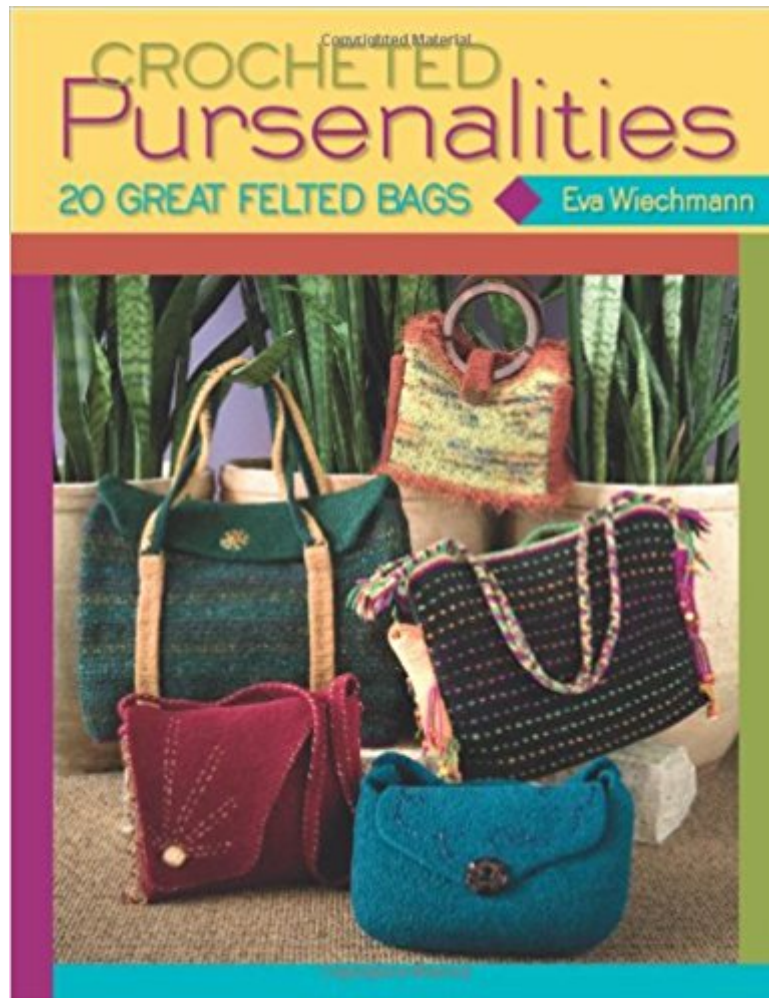

Crocheted Pursenalities a book by Eva Weichman is an oldie but goodie. Originally published in paperback in 2007, it is still going strong and is now an ebook. The book is composed of 20 great felted bags. This spring season is the season of the knitted and crocheted handbag. Using this book as a guide will have your spring wardrobe getting noticed, especially if done in this seasons color trends. Eva starts you off with the crochet basics and tells you how to finish your purse with felting. The skill level of the patterns range from beginner to experienced. More than half of the patterns are easy and beginner. No matter what the level, the results are professional and stylish, covering everyday wear to dressy. If you enjoy making handbags, you may be able to find her two previous books Pursenalities: 20 Great Knitted and Felted Bags and Pursenality Plus: 20 New Felted Bags by Martingale and Company. Popular author Eva Wiechmann has owned her own knitting and needlework shop, Eva's Needlework, since 1987.

The finished purses are beautiful and very current. The pictures are great. The down side of this book is that all the patterns are VERY yarn specific and usually call for at least 3 different types of yarn. (with various percentages of wool content) Also, in order to achieve the finished look many embellishments are required, i.e. decorative stitching, gromets, hardware and the tools to use the hardware. Even a pattern titled EASY required 2 different types of yarn with very specific wool blends to go with the felting yarn. The finished purses look great, but anyone who felts knows if you change up your blends you may get a very different result. I plan to use this book as inspiration to create my own ideas. I will not attempt to following the patterns.
