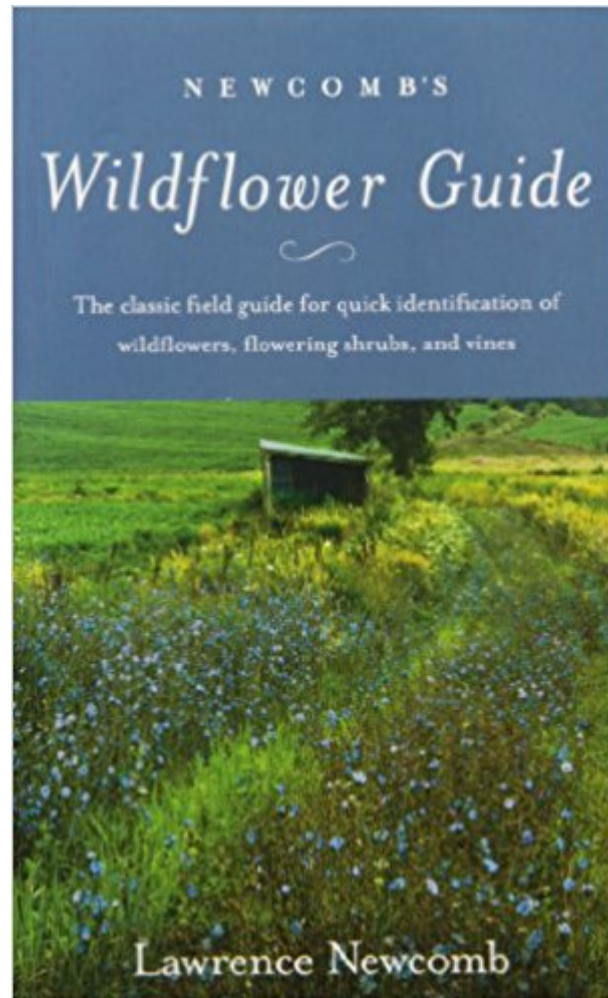

key - like method are great. The book I received is not the same edition shown in the picture. The image is of the newer blue cover, and I received the yellow edition from the 70's. The cover is a little bent and the pages a tiny bit wavy, but it's totally useable and I don't mind at all.

This is NOT the edition that is pictured, which is the one I used in class years ago and the one I was searching for. The information is still relevant, but I did not really appreciate the addition of weblinks in the text.
