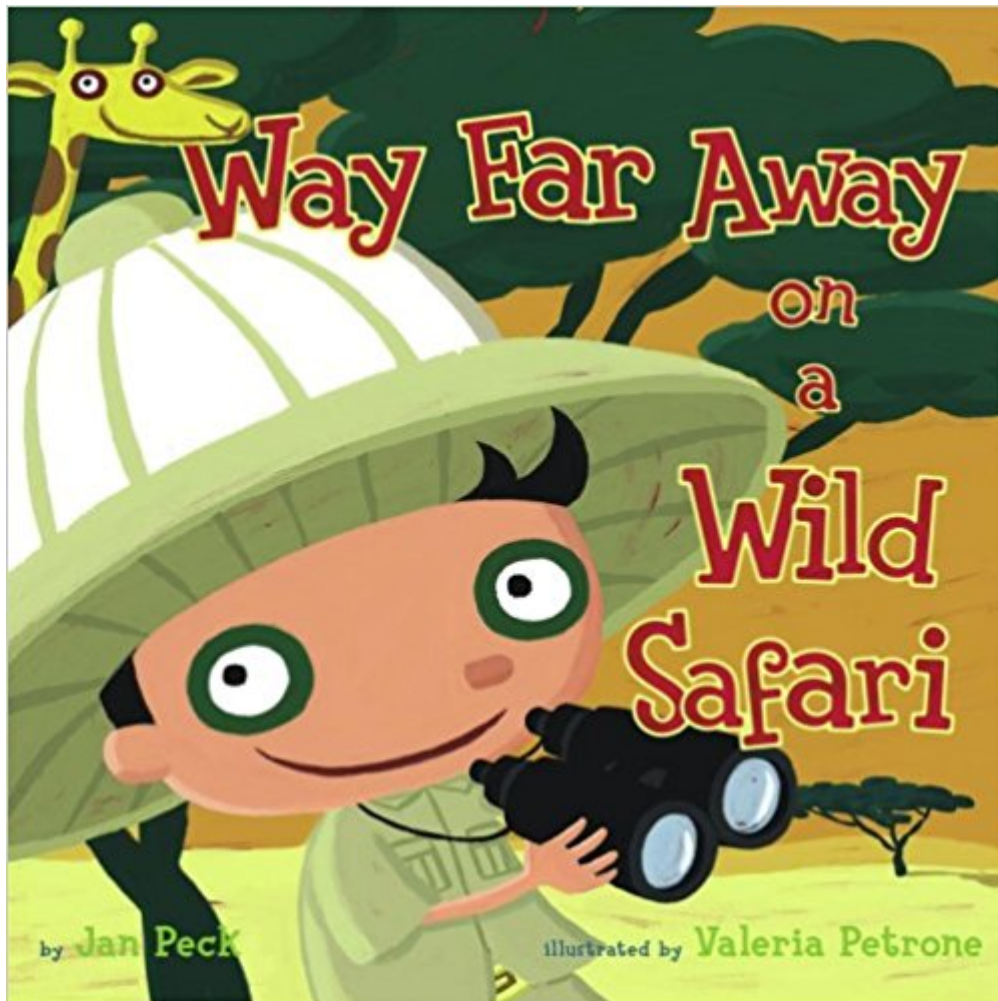

PreSchool-K "Following on the heels of *Way Down Deep in the Deep Blue Sea* (2004) and *Way Up High in a Tall Green Tree* (2005, both S & S), Peck and Petrone feature a pith-helmeted boy visiting the animals of the African savannah. Each spread focuses on one animal with six rhythmic, patterned lines of text featuring an action the creature is taking (sloshing, spying, roaring, zigzagging, etc). In the end, the animals are revealed to be cookies baked by Grandma. The full-color illustrations are digitally rendered in bold lines and bright colors. Although there is little dramatic action, readers looking for books with a safari theme or for African animals will find adventure enough in the cozy cadences of these vignettes." One of our favorites! They recite "Hike away!" at the appropriate time on each page. We also act out this book with their stuffed animals.
