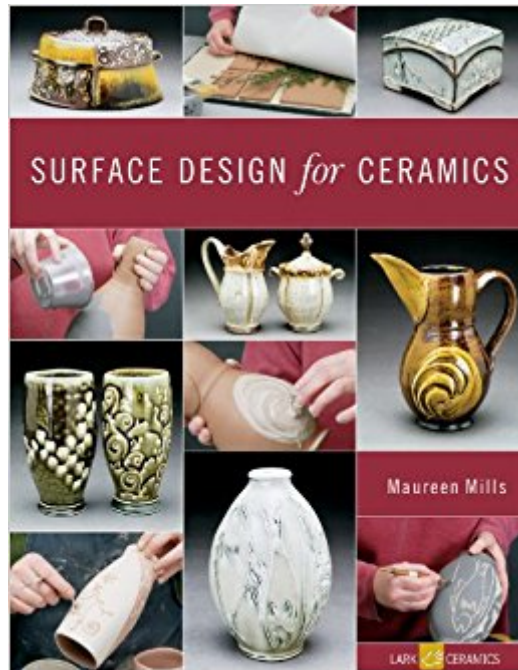

This book was a real disappointment, nothing new at all. A lot of the illustrations are from reduction, salt, & wood firing. This is the second Lark book I have bought & neither one was worth buying. I won't buy another Lark book. Totally overrated!

This is a beautiful and inspiring book. I've been working in clay for thirty years and this book illustrates every surface treatment I've ever seen and even a few that are new to me. The explanations for how to achieve each effect are clear and simple (for the most part). The photos of the work are gorgeous.

I got this book during my first semester in ceramics and it came on very handy. I tried many of the methods depicted inside and had great results. Really good source of information for people starting out with clay.

This book is neither for the beginner nor the pro. Not enough detail for the novice, nothing new and exciting for the pro.

I was disappointed in the content. I have a number of surface design ceramic books, but this was my least helpful one.
